MEETING OUR COMMUNITY'S TOP HEALTH NEEDS

Every three years, Genesis HealthCare System and local health departments conduct a Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA) to determine the top health needs in our region. The survey results outline key health data and community members' feedback about the health needs in our area. In collaboration with local health departments, Genesis HealthCare System prioritized programs to meet the community's needs.

Our 2024 six priority health needs were: mental health issues, heart disease, cancer, stroke, diabetes and social determinants of health.*

Genesis Educational Services monitored community CPR and first aid classes and provided certification cards through a partnership with Zane State College.



BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SPOTLIGHT



Added support

Behavioral Health staff available in the Emergency Department 24/7. **Dedicated case manager** available for patients in the hospital with a history of behavioral health needs. \$2,083 invested in 57 calls to survivors of sexual assault. **\$4,000** dedicated to addiction support. **49 hours** devoted to community collaboratives in mental health.

The future of Behavioral Health

In 2024, project planning began for additional behavioral health services.

Youth Crisis Stabilization Center

Planned to open in 2026, Genesis will offer an additional option of care to our behavioral health youth in need.
